This will enable the Transfer Center to implement targeted strategies to improve transfer student success and enhance the overall student experience.

Methodology

- Identify transfer student trends, utilizing the <u>data profiles data</u> available on the ASIR website to analyze the number and demographics of transfer students over time, and identify trends in the academic preparation major choice of transfer students within different colleges and departments over time.
- **Review the research** on what we currently know about transfer students, their choices, and their performance by examining the <u>New Transfer Mythbuster</u> dashboard and reading the attached <u>brief</u>.
- Assess transfer student success by using the <u>SDSU At A Glance SD Campus</u> and <u>SDSU At A</u> <u>Glance - IV Campus</u> dashboards to analyze the continuation and graduation rates and transfer students compared to native students.
- **Prioritize resource allocation** by identifying programs with high demand from transfer students, particularly those from underrepresented groups, and developing comprehensive orientation and targeted advising programs for transfer and underrepresented students
